

Determining Care That's Right for You

There are a variety of recovery approaches you can consider on your journey. Your treatment plan may include one or more of these services:

- **One-on-one** counseling (children and adults)
- Couples/marriage counseling
- · Family counseling
- Group counseling
- Psychiatry (children and adults)
- Art therapy
- Anger management
- **EMDR** (Eye Movement Desensitization and Reprocessing) for treating PTSD or trauma
- Case management, to help navigate everyday life and make sure your basic needs are met (e.g. enough food, housing, clothing, etc.)
- Partial hospitalization programs (PHP)
- Intensive outpatient programs (IOP)
- Medication-Assisted Treatment (MAT) for opioid or alcohol use disorder
- Peer support

Many Signature Health patients have what's known as a dual diagnosis, meaning they receive treatment for both a mental health condition and substance use disorder (SUD).

Patients can receive primary care or infectious disease services without receiving behavioral health services.

Primary Care

Our providers care for patients of all ages, from newborns to seniors:

- Annual well exams
- Prevention/management of conditions like high blood pressure and diabetes
- Vaccinations and screenings
- · Treatment of illnesses or injuries
- Sports physicals
- · Women's and reproductive health
- · Sexual health

Infectious Disease

- Education, screenings and treatment for hepatitis, HIV, and sexually transmitted infections (STIs)
- HIV prevention (PrEP and PEP)

Paying for Care

Signature Health primarily serves Medicaid, Medicare and uninsured patients, regardless of ability to pay. We offer a sliding fee scale program, which means the cost for services could be as low as \$0, \$5, \$10 or \$20, depending on household income and size. Our financial specialists also can help get eligible patients signed up for Medicaid coverage.

Private insurance is accepted only in some cases when patients receive grant-supported sexual and reproductive health services.
